TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entrants are only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over.
3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
4. The Promotion Period begins at opening hours on Saturday 11 October 2025 and closes on 2:00 pm on Sunday 12 October 2025.
5. To be eligible, individuals must complete the following steps during the Promotional Period:
 - a. Complete all the fields on the form and submit to the centre database; and
 - b. Make one or more purchases of \$40 that are Eligible Transactions.

An “Eligible Transaction” is a transaction made by an entrant who makes a purchase at a Participating Retailer during the Promotion Period, but does not include: payment for services (e.g. electricity, gas, telephone), registrations (e.g. motor vehicle registration), premiums (e.g. insurance and health fund premiums), rates, electronic receipts (on phones) or ‘click and collect’ (online purchases), subscriptions, medical and cosmetic services, TAB, liquor and cigarette purchases, deposits or payments to financial institutions or any similar payments (including payments made to Australia Post, lay-by transactions, newsagency and lotteries purchases), each of which will not qualify as an Eligible Transaction.
6. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these Terms and Conditions, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the promotion. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the discretion of the Promoter. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
7. Incomplete or indecipherable entries will be deemed invalid.
8. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
9. The Promoter's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. Promotion Prize or “prize”: There are a total of 360 prizes. Each prize is provided instantly at the Food Cart between the hours of 11am – 2pm on Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 October. The prize is 1 x \$5 Food Court Voucher, per person. Each prizewinner can only win once.
11. Any ancillary costs associated with redeeming the Promotion Prize are not included. Any unused balance of the Promotion Prize will not be awarded as cash. Redemption of the Promotion Prize is subject to any terms and conditions of the issuer including those specified on the Promotion Prize.
12. If the winner of any Promotion Prize is under the age of 18 years, the Promotion Prize will be awarded to the winner's nominated parent or guardian on the winner's behalf.

13. If any Promotion Prize (or part of any Promotion Prize) is unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute the Promotion Prize (or that part of the Promotion Prize) with a prize to the equal value and/or specification, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority.
14. Total Promotion Prize pool value is up to \$1,800 (excluding GST).
15. The Winner must collect the Promotion Prize from the Food Court Cart on the promotion days only of 11 October and 12 October 2025 during the promotional times of 11am – 2pm.

Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion.

Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any entry that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in gift value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by an entrant or (f) use of/taking of a prize.

The Promoter collects personal information ("PI") in order to conduct the promotion and may, for this purpose, disclose such PI to third parties, including but not limited to agents, contractors, service providers, gift suppliers and, as required, to Australian regulatory authorities. The Privacy Policy also contains information about how entrants may opt out, access, update or correct their PI, how entrants may complain about a breach of the Australian Privacy Principles or any other applicable law and how those complaints will be dealt with.
